2. Free Voluntary COVID-19 Testing for MBTA Contractor/Vendor**

Dear Valued MBTA Contractor/Vendor,

In our continued effort to keep our contractors/vendors informed during these challenging times, we want to make you aware of two important developments related to the COVID-19 pandemic:

### 1. MASS GOVERNOR BAKER - COVID-19 ORDER 45

*On July 24, 2020, Governor Baker signed COVID-19 Order 45, "Order Instituting a Mandatory 14-Day Quarantine Requirement for Travelers Arriving in Massachusetts" ("Order"). Under the terms of the Order, all persons arriving in Massachusetts on or after August 1, 2020, are required to quarantine for fourteen (14) days, in accordance with Massachusetts Department of Public Health (DPH) standards unless they are coming from a State designated as lower-risk by DPH[1]; have a negative COVID-19 test result from a sample taken not longer than 72 hours prior to arrival in Massachusetts and can produce proof of the negative test result on request, or the person falls into a limited number of exceptions.*

#### ➤ What do I do once I get my test results?

If you have tested positive for COVID-19, please contact your medical provider as well as your employer following prescribed company policy.
